Role Description: Line Helper

Hourly Wage Range: Starting at \$34.84; Union position

Regular Business Hours: 4 days/10 hours: Monday – Thursday, 7:00am – 5:30pm

Job Duties:

The Line Helper will perform physical labor necessary to assist with the installation, maintenance, reparation and/or operation of company equipment and facilities. Performance of duties will include: clean-up work, debris removal, loading/unloading materials, storage of items, digging, grounds maintenance, fueling vehicles, cleaning equipment, and performing work using various hand-held tools. The successful candidate may be required to drive company vehicles to transport personnel and equipment to and from work sites, as well as running errands as assigned. Curriculum will include on-the-job training and completion of a skills check-off list to be jointly completed by the Line Foreman and the Line Helper.

There are instances where a Line Helper will be required to safely lift 75 lbs from floor to waist, from waist to overhead, ability to carry loads up to 75 lbs with both hands, pushing and pulling an excess of 100 lbs. Job duties of the Line Helper require sustained bending and twisting at the waist and neck; reaching forward, to the side, across the body and overhead. Additional requirements are forceful grip and pinch: manipulation of small objects; balancing on one or both legs during dynamic activities: manipulation of large objects during activities requiring balance and sustained, variable postures.

A Line Helpers may have the potential of being promoted into a three-year Lineman apprenticeship program and, ultimately, into a position as a Journeyman Lineman. Successful skill progression and an available apprenticeship opening will be prerequisites for one's entry into the Lineman apprenticeship program at Lakeview Light & Power.

Experience Required:

- Must have a High School Diploma, GED, or equivalent
- Must be at least 18 years of age and legally allowed to work in the United States
- Possess a current WA Driver's License
- Job offer is contingent upon successful completion of a company-paid physical, drug screen, and background check

Experience Preferred:

- Class A Commercial Driver's License certification applicable to WA State
- Current certification for telescopic boom trucks with both a swing cab (TLL) and fixed cab (TSS)
- Possess and maintain CPR certification, flagging, and first aid card
