

Educational Scholarship Program



Lakeview Light and Power is offering three \$2,000 Scholarships to the children of Lakeview Light and Power members and/or customers who are graduating from high school in the spring of 2019. Applications are available through our website at www.lakeviewlight.com. Lakeview Light and Power will be funding an additional \$2,000 scholarship to current students of Clover Park Technical College. Applicants for the Lakeview Scholarship Awards must submit the following documents to the offices of Lakeview Light and Power on or before February 14, 2019:

- 1. A completed application form, available online at www.lakeviewlight.com.*
- 2. A certified copy of their transcript to include grades from the 1st semester of their senior year.*
- 3. Your choice of a one page single spaced typed essay, a 5 minute video or power point presentation detailing what area of study you plan to pursue and why, and how this will help you better your community.*
- 4. A one page typed summary detailing their extra-curricular activities on behalf of their school and or community.*

The Lakeview Light and Power Board of Directors Scholarship Committee will finalize their decision as to the names of the 2019-2020 Scholarship Award Recipients on or before February 28th, 2019. All applicants will receive written notice as to the status of their application.

Scholarship award applications are available online at www.lakeviewlight.com, and are due no later than February 14, 2019.

DETAILED INFORMATION REGARDING THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS PROGRAM

1. The Board of Directors of Lakeview Light & Power has established a scholarship awards program to assist children of members and/or customers with funding continuing education.
2. This year the Corporation will award \$8,000.00 in scholarships.
3. The Scholarship Committee is composed of three Directors, appointed by the President of the Corporation.
4. The Scholarship Committee has the responsibility for screening applicants to establish eligibility.
5. The Scholarship Committee makes the final selection of award candidates. These selections are made from the approved applications.



PROVISIONS:

(A) ELIGIBILITY:

All children of Lakeview Light & Power members or customers, excluding persons related to Board Members and/or Employees of Lakeview Light & Power, are eligible candidates.

(B) APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS:

1. An applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
2. An applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited college, university, or training institute.
3. Award Candidates must agree to personally accept the scholarship award at the Annual Meeting of Lakeview Light & Power on March 19, 2019.

(C) LIMITATIONS:

1. Scholarships are awarded for the 2019-2020 academic year only.
2. Scholarships are paid directly to the scholarship recipient's college, university or training institute upon receipt of appropriate documentation that the scholarship candidate has been accepted as a full-time or part-time student.
3. Scholarship funds are to be used to pay tuition. If money remains after tuition is paid, the scholarship recipient may purchase books and/or other course related material and submit receipts to the funds administrator to obtain reimbursement of such expense.
4. Unused scholarship funds will be retained by Lakeview Light & Power. Scholarship funds that have been sent to a college, university or training institute that are not used by the scholarship recipient will be refunded to Lakeview Light & Power, not to the student.
5. Scholarships cannot be renewed. A scholarship recipient can only receive one Lakeview Light & Power scholarship.
6. Scholarships are not assignable.

(D) SELECTION CRITERIA

General Selection Criteria will include the following considerations:

1. Verification of the applicant's eligibility.
2. The quality of the applicant's essay, which must be a minimum of one single spaced typed essay, or video, which must be at least 5 minutes in length, or power point presentation detailing what area of study you plan to pursue and why, and how this will help better your community.
3. The quality of the applicant's coursework and their grade point average as detailed on their high school transcript.
4. The applicant's extra-curricular school and community involvement as detailed on their activity chronology sheet.

(E) APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Applicants for scholarships must complete the application form and submit the required supporting documents as outlined above.
2. The closing date for submitting the application and supporting documents is set by the Scholarship Committee of Lakeview Light & Power.
